Investigate- We considered our design brief, and looked at existing structures at the park such as swings, slides and seesaws.

- We have used construction kits to practise building freestanding structures, along with practising other skills, such as cutting, folding and joining.

Design- Using sketches and labels, we designed different models of freestanding park structures. From this, we chose the best design, which we based our final product on.
