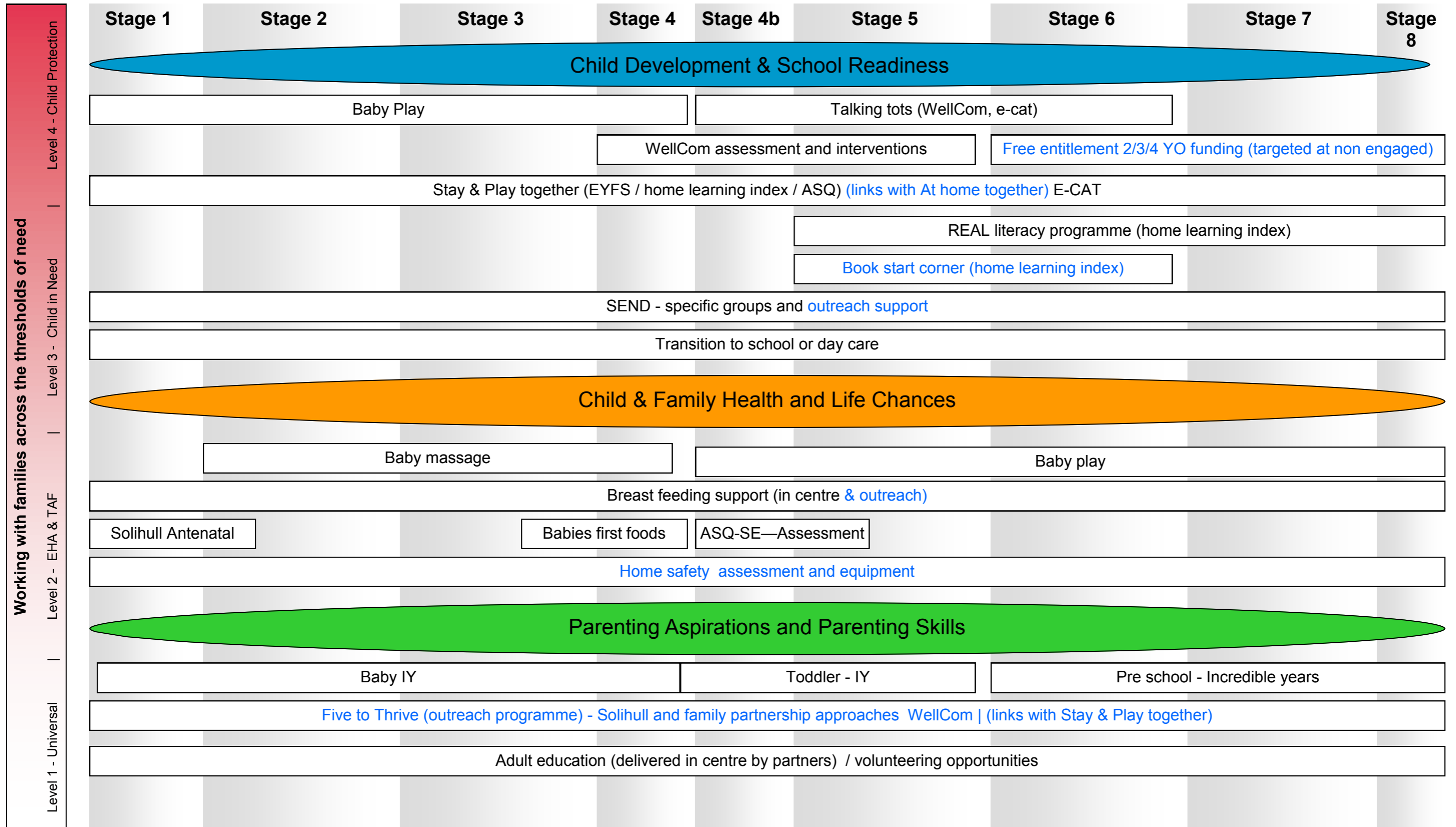


# Salford Early Help Offer Under 5's

Stage 1 (pregnancy) - Stage 2 Birth (10-14days) - Stage 3 (6-8 weeks) - Stage 4 (9 Months) Stage 4b (18Months) - Stage 5 (24 Months) - Stage 6 (Nursery) - Stage 7 (reception) - Stage 8 (reception end)
