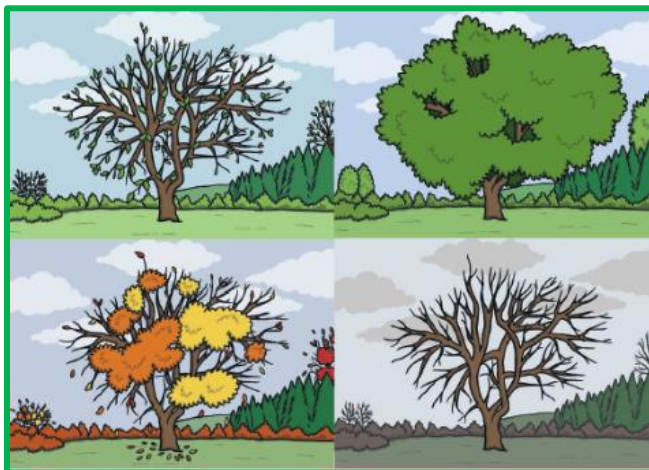

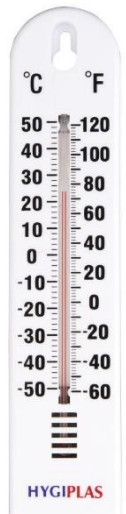

Spelling	Definition
Weather	The conditions in the air above the earth such as wind, rain, or temperature, especially at a particular time over a particular area.
Seasons	Four divisions of the year, marked by particular weather patterns and daylight hours.
Thermometer	Instrument for measuring temperature.
Observation	The action of monitoring something over time.
Weather forecast	Description of the current weather and predictions of future weather.
